This evening, the Kiwanis Club of Glendale was proud to host our annual *Scholarship Dinner* at the CNL Center of Christ the King HS. Each year, we present deserving students with financial assistance to pursue their academic careers. The students submit written applications, which are screened by a committee of club members, and the recipients are rated on academic excellence, good citizenship, and a sustained record of community service. Extracurricular activities are also important, as they demonstrate a well-rounded person. This year, we awarded a remarkable *twenty-three* awards in ten categories. The scholarships are funded in several ways: Families of former members endow a scholarship to honor their family member, club members donate to scholarships funds in memory of past members and families, or funds are established by Club Presidents as their major emphasis during their year. This year, President Ingrid Huber established a scholarship in memory of her father George Ritter and her mother-in-law Mathilda Huber, awarded to students pursuing careers in trade and technical study.

Their were ninety-six students, families and club members in attendance, and Pres Ingrid opened the meeting with an Invocation by Karen Kramer, followed by the Pledge of Allegiance and 'My Country Tis of thee'. She began to present the awards, first by calling on club members to speak about the Scholarship Honorees, and then reading a brief bio on each student, presenting each one with a certificate and an envelope containing the award. We had several special guests in attendance: Bob Scheer, son of Charlie and Anna Scheer, and Lorraine Gering, who spoke about their loved ones and their accomplishments. Also, Mike Porcelli spoke about the necessity for trade and technical vocations. It was an emotional moment for all the presenters, for sure.

After Happy \$\$ and a rousing 'When Kiwanis Calls', the meeting closed, and everyone was so grateful that our club puts in so much time and effort (and over \$14,000) to reward students for their hard work and accomplishments.
