After introducing the Past Leadership (there were many), she introduced a longtime member of our club, who came to take his turn as Sheriff. Joe Bonventre joined us today, and was pleased to see that Glendale spirit was alive and well. He received a rousing 'How Do You Do?' from our members, and we immediately put him to work, because Lucien Matej joined us as well. Lucien and Joe go way back, and although he hasn't been to a meeting in a while, he wanted to see Joe and our guest speaker. He was so happy to be back that he paid for lunch for the entire club. That, my friends, is one generous offer! Many of our members were thrilled and grateful, and put up their lunch money as Happy \$\$ as a result. Thank you very much, Lucien.

Today's Guests: PG Joe Ruggiero joined us today, and introduced his friend Toni Contone; Vin Arcuri had his aide Maria along; Dorie Figliola introduced her friend and composter extraordinaire Gwen Ossenfort; PP Vinnie Alberici had his sister Madeline join him today; DPLG Kerrie Hansen treated her mother Pat to lunch; Rudy Jonke introduced his friend Jack Rohan and treated our guest speaker, Ignazio 'Iggy' Azzara; Claudia Huber was a guest of her papa DPP Richie. Ignazio 'Iggy' Azzara is no stranger to our club, and we always look forward to his visits, to enlighten us on what is happening at the *Department of Sanitation*. He has been with DSNY for 25 years, and is the Borough Chief of West Queens. New York City keeps his department very busy. DSNY collects 24 million pounds of trash, recycling, and compostable material every day. They operate 59 district garages, and manage a fleet of more than 2,000 rear-loading collection trucks, 450 mechanical brooms, 705 salt spreaders, and several dozen specialized machines to clean and plow bike lanes. His district alone serves 1.2 million people.

Everyone had lots of questions about the hot topic of the year: the Garbage Bin Replacement program. Beginning on November 12, 2024, all trash must be set out in a bin (55 gallons or less) with a secure lid. This applies to all single- and two-family homes, and buildings with up to nine apartments. These bins are specially designed to be rolled to the truck and placed on a lift to be opened and dumped automatically. The secure locking lid will hopefully solve the excessive rat problem the City is facing. The gray trash bin sells for around \$53 and should be ordered by October 1 to insure delivery on time.



Naturally, this program isn't sitting well with many residents who feel their current bins are secure and do not need replacing. Iggy maintained that the design of the new bins and the auto-dumping feature will make for more efficient



service, to free up workers for other sanitation duties. There are many questions to be resolved, but with men and women like Iggy on the case, it will be accomplished.
